2016 INSPIRADO

The 2016 Inspirado is the Bordeaux blend of the estate and checks in as 83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Merlot, and the rest Petit Verdot. It has an exotic, complex bouquet of black raspberry and cassis fruits intermixed with some forest floor, dried flowers, and cedar. This carries to a medium to full-bodied red that has sweet tannin, a rounded, approachable style, and loads to love.

Lastly, the 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon is even better, with an awesome bouquet of sweet cassis, cedarwood, incense, and dried flowers. As with all the wines from Celia Welch, this beauty is impeccably balanced, has medium to full-bodied richness and depth, subtle background oak, and a great finish. It shines for its purity and elegance as well as its depth of fruit and intensity. Drink it over the coming two decades or more. — Jeb Dunnuck
