The dark brooding aromatics from this wine come from one of the best vintages mother nature has given Napa Valley this decade. A beautiful blend of dense lilac and violets with dark raspberry and fresh cassis on the nose. Followed by balance with ripe and fresh black and red fruits with gentle acidity and generous tannins. The wine finishes with finesse and polish.

Recoltant is produced by Julien Fayard, who is absolutely at the top of his game. Recoltant is a composition of declassified barrels from premium Cabernet that Julien has unparalleled access to in the Napa Valley. The final blend was created with fruit sourced from several celebrated sub-regions throughout Napa Valley, and Julien made the wine with the same standards of excellence that he practices in all of his projects.

Julien Fayard learned his craft at Château Lafite Rothschild, before gaining even more valuable experience as Director of Winemaking for Philippe Melka at elite Napa Valley producers like Lail, Gemstone, Hundred Acre, and Mastery.
