TASTING NOTES

A BRILLIANT BEAM OF SUNSHINE IN THE GLASS, THIS VIBRANT SAUVIGNON BLANC SHARES AROMAS OF APPLE BLOSSOM, WHITE STONE, PEACH KERNEL, AND CROISSANT. THE PALATE OPENS INTO FRAGRANT CITRUS, MOVING FROM PINEAPPLE TO JUICY MANDARIN ORANGE AND TANGELO WITH GENTLE NOTES OF YOUNG PEACH SUSPENDED IN THE SUPPLE, TENDER TEXTURE. A MOUTHWATERING WAVE OF GOLDEN DELICIOUS APPLES CARRIES THE WINE TO A CLEAN, ZESTY FINISH.
