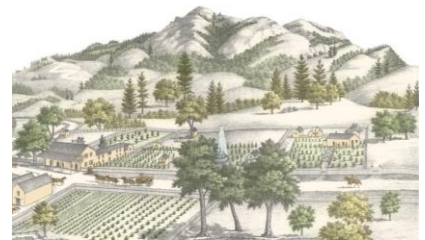
TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Altruria Cabernet Sauvignon is a beautifully structured and pleasurable wine. A warm and inviting nose, evokes dark cherries, violets, and cardamon spice along with notes of grilled meat and sage. The opulent palate brings dark fruit flavors of cassis, blackberry, and plums. Throughout the mid-palate and finish, cocoa nib, bergamot tea, and mint notes build complexity and depth in the wine. The angular tannins provide a backbone that guides the substantial power of this wine into a gentle and perfectly balanced finish.
