2019 Memento Mori Cabernet Sauvignon captures your attention from first glance proceeds to keep it until it chooses to let you go. Energetic waves of blackberries, boysenberries, cassis, cigar box, spiced mocha and clove bound out of the glass, continuing to expand and evolve with time in the glass. Pulling fruit from all of the vineyards that we work with, a decadent mixture of black, blue and red fruits are supported by expressive minerality, vibrant acidity and plush tannins. Aged for 22 months in 100% new French oak, this a seductive and sensual offering that highlight a vintage full of life and energy, and is sure to deliver pleasure now and for years to come.
