2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA VALLEY

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Band of Vintners Cabernet Sauvignon was defined by a long, warm summer and a mild finish to the growing season. Very few heat spikes and foggy mornings set the stage for a vibrant and expressive wine that is easy to drink now. In the glass, a spice box awakens the olfactory senses followed by sandalwood, lightly toasted oak barrels, a slice of warm brioche, and violets. The acidity and tannins work harmoniously together to deliver a clean and smooth texture on the palate with notes of blueberry and anise, as well as an earthiness reminiscent of an old-world profile.
