### 2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON, SONOMA

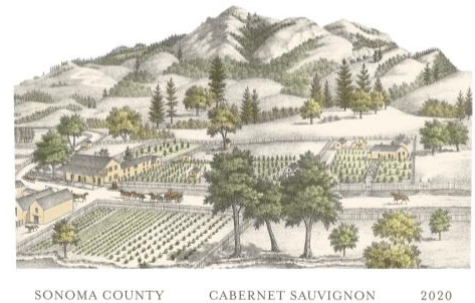
#### TASTING NOTES

Perfumed high-toned aromas of violet, lavender and boysenberry fruit provide a welcoming first impression on the nose. Black cherry, pomegranate and clove spice add layers to the olfactory prowess of this wine. The palate offers a tart briary fruit profile along with cedar and blonde tobacco. 2021 is a beautifully structured vintage that brings a harmonious balance of dark fruit and savory flavors that carry to a complex and layered finish.
