ABOUT THE BRAND

Not wanting to wait until they were in their sundown years, the three founders started Memento Mori, which means 'remember your mortality' in Latin, with the express intent of 'Remembering to Live'. The team's first vintage was in 2010 and only produced 150 cases to ensure quality and hone the wine's direction. We source from famed vineyards in Napa Valley to produce one flagship wine. Stylistically we wanted to acknowledge the incredible terroir of Napa Valley and how it produces world class Cabernet but at the same time pay homage to Left Bank Bordeaux which is known for its subtlety and longevity.

TASTING NOTES: The signature blend that brings together all the vineyards that have become part of our story, this wine perfectly embodies the intersection of opulent power and sophisticated grace. Black plums, wild blueberries, cassis, lilacs, forest floor, and spicy oak bound out of the glass, only to be matched only by a finesse-laden palate full of dark fruits, rocky minerals, graphite, black currant, cigar box, and cedar. Aged in 100% new French oak for 22 months and wrapped in a cloak of beautiful, finely grained tannins, this is a dynamic and sexy offering dripping with substance whose best days are clearly ahead of it.
