TASTING NOTES

The signature blend that brings together all the vineyards that have become part of the Memento Mori story, this wine perfectly embodies the intersection of opulent power and sophisticated grace. Black plums, wild blueberries, cassis, lilacs, forest floor, and spicy oak bound out of the glass, only to be matched by a finesse-laden palate full of dark fruits, rocky minerals, graphite, black currant, cigar box, and cedar. Aged in 100% new French oak for 22 months and wrapped in a cloak of beautiful, finely grained tannins, this is a dynamic offering dripping with substance whose best days are clearly ahead of it.

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BACKGROUND

The wine is named for a life-embracing philosophy born of a deep appreciation for the ties that bind. Each of its' three founders have triumphed over adversity and learned to value not only life, but the passion and hard work that drive it, making them uniquely qualified to launch an uncompromising brand. Memento Mori which means 'remember your mortality' in Latin, with the express intent of 'Remembering to Live'. The team's first vintage was 2010 and only 150 cases were produced to ensure quality and hone the wine's direction. Memento Mori is source from famed vineyards in Napa Valley to produce one flagship wine. The result is a world class Cabernet which is known for its subtlety and longevity.
