Shibumi Knoll Vineyards exemplifies this concept through an estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir made by Thomas Rivers Brown. Located just north of Saint Helena in the heart of the Napa Valley, the property includes a small knoll and two-acre parcel is a rocky .75-acre Cabernet Sauvignon vineyard planted in 1996. For nearly two decades, the wines have been adorned by critics and wine buyers alike.

This vintage of Chardonnay has a beautiful fresh feel. It's well balanced with a sunshine citrus nose. The taste is of pineapple accents, apricot and nectarine essence. It coats your palate and warms your throat. The finish is long and lovely making you want more. This chardonnay is sophisticated with an adventurous spirit.

“Coming from a vineyard on the Sonoma Coast and aged in 25% new barrels, the 2019 Pinot Noir has a darker strawberry, raspberry, dried herb, and spice-driven bouquet as well as medium-bodied richness and depth on the palate.
